 Review and update TVI's existing and unpublished courses as needed.
 Work with TVI staff to publish existing content as per content plan/ timeline.
Developing or commissioning new content
• Develop or commission and manage development of new content as per the plan.
 Publish as per the plan, including coordinating testing prior to publishing.
Work closely with online platform technical staff to
ensure smooth integration into other online platform functions.
Ongoing training and mentoring
 Provide mentoring to TVI full time staff on development and publishing of content.
• Develop instruction manual which includes step by step development and publishing of content (including any templates) and maintenance, updating of content.
